Drop off/Pickup	Parents and students will remain in their car for student's health screen
	 Parents will not be allowed to enter the building – SpotTV will be utilize to view students
	Students will enter building with mask on, place belongings in bag and sanitize hand and feet
	 Students will maintain social distance and will be brought to car by a coach after class
Class Management	• Students will be provided bags that they use for shoes, water bottle, and hand sanitizer
