 - Limit based on changes in pandemic development and Governor’s executive orders

Building Preparation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Utilizing Victory electrostatic cleaner to disinfect building throughout the day • Engaged Cintas for all touchless dispensers and cleaning chemicals • Reconfigured lobby and sink area to provide for social distancing • Silver Defender antimicrobial tape on all high touch areas • SpotTV for parents viewing
Employee Preparation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PPE preparation set by NJDOH and class management training • Wellness policy including daily health screen and temperature checks • Staff will limit contact with children, except where spotting is necessary for safety
Drop off/Pickup	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents and students will remain in their car for student’s health screen • Parents will not be allowed to enter the building – SpotTV will be utilize to view students • Students will enter building with mask on, place belongings in bag and sanitize hand and feet • Students will maintain social distance and will be brought to car by a coach after class
Class Management	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will be provided bags that they use for shoes, water bottle, and hand sanitizer • Classes will be conducted with social distancing when practical (exception spotting) • Equipment will be cleaned between rotations • Classes will conclude at 50 minutes to allow for hand washing and pickup
